PROJECT AIMS:

Empower young adults to talk about global sustainability issues and design new solutions to meet them.

- We created a conference where students could meet and talk with their peers around issues that would affect them.
- We invited professionals from around the world to work with our students to give them the experience of working with others.
- We worked with a whole year of year 8s the school to explore global issues, their stake in the world and their opportunity to affect their outcome.



ACTION:

Create a multifaceted conference from the issue that students worked on to the roles they played.

- Putting students across a whole year into roles challenged them to rise to the challenge and to understand cooperation.
- We created ideas together with the support of professionals and presented their ideas.
