## Building Capacity for Youth Participation in North Belfast



## PROJECT AIMS: This curriculum based project aims to

- engage young people with the principles of democracy and participation;
- research young people's experience of (and perspectives on) participation in their school and community;
- disseminate findings from the research to local schools and local political representatives.

**ACTIONS:** 

- Term 1 developing and delivering a unit of work on democracy and participation
- Term 2 visit to the NI Assembly at Stormont for workshops and meeting with local MLA; working with the Centre for Children's Rights Queen's University Belfast to develop a survey of peers across schools in North Belfast
- Term 3 advocacy workshop; dissemination of findings from survey to local schools; lobbying local representatives

This project has given our girls a fantastic opportunity to learn more about participation in their community and to engage with their peers across North Belfast (Principal, Mercy College)

## IMPACT: It is hoped that the outcomes from this project will be:

- increased awareness amongst young people in North Belfast of opportunities to participate in their school and local community;
- contribution to relationship building between schools in North Belfast;
- raising local political representatives' awareness of the needs of young people in the community
